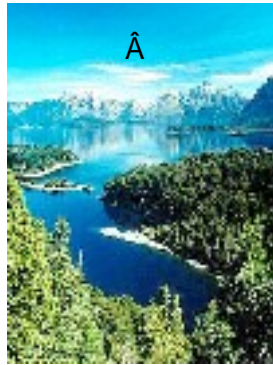

Antarctic – the Great White Continent If you feel adventurous and crave close contact with some of the most wondrous landscapes in the world, why not treat yourself to a completely unique experience: visit Argentina and join one of the expeditions to Antarctica. Departing from Ushuaia in Tierra del Fuego, you can avail of a variety of sailing vessels and a variety of programmes. Sailing tours take place between November and March but in November the ice is at its most spectacular and it is also time for mating and nesting for penguins and other birds. December and January bring the longest days of summer with spectacular light and penguin chicks hatching. The duration of the sailings varies from 9 to 19 nights and the highlights of this adventure to Antarctica are the Beagle Channel, Falkland Islands, South Georgia, Elephant Island, South Shetland Islands, the Antarctic Peninsula, Drake Passage, Weddell Sea and South Orkney Islands.
